### **NEW GATE ENTRY PROCEDURES:**

If you do not have a military ID card, please note: we are required to submit the base entry request to Security Forces by 12 noon on the Tuesday before the Thursday luncheon, therefore it imperative that you submit these requests to us before the deadline. When you submit a person's name(s), the following is required: Last name, first name, middle initial, drivers license number, and state of issue. This information must be as it appears on the driver's license or other forms of identification. Children under eighteen years old require no identification, but if this information is available, we recommend that it be included. For foreign nationals, the passport number and country or origin is sufficient. If a person has no driver's license or passport, their SSAN will suffice, however some valid official form of photo identification is required.

### **ARE YOU INFORMED ABOUT DBIDS?**

**DBIDS (DEFENSE BIOMETRIC IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM)** is a DoD system designed to easily verify access authorization of personnel entering military bases by using barcode and fingerprint biometric identification. BIDS uses a reliable database that verifies a person's ID card against a registered DoD data base.

All active duty, civilian employees, and retirees/dependents must register at various locations around the base such as the Visitor Reception Facility, BX, Commissary, Clinic and Fitness Center.
